

## Kingston Integrated Care Community of Practice

### 26th June 2019 Event Summary

The second Integrated Care Community of Practice for the Kingston region (within both Monash and Alfred Health catchments) was held on the 26th June 2019 at Woodlands Golf Club. The event ran from 7am to 8.30am and was introduced by Dr Gary Yip, Alfred Health. A panel discussed the local PACER program and older persons' mental health service at Monash Health. The panel comprised Victoria Police; CATT Monash Health and Consultant Psychiatrist Dr Ian Presnell, Kingston Hospital, Monash Health. The panel then answered audience questions. Dr Gary Yip provided post panel commentary and facilitated further discussion with the panel and audience.
