

Stonnington Port Phillip Integrated Care Community of Practice

1st March 2019 Event Summary

The inaugural Integrated Care Community of Practice for the Stonnington Port Phillip region (within the Alfred Health catchment) was held on the 1st March 2019 at The Vincent in Albert Park. The event ran from 7am to 8.30am and was introduced by Dr Gary Yip General Physician Alfred Health.

The breakfast event featured a video vignette of people who are carers of adults with significant mental health conditions which was provided by Dr Tina Campbell, Director of Healthily, patient education platform. There was subsequent roundtable discussion followed by wider audience commentary. A poll (slido) was used at the end of proceedings for anonymous feedback and optional networking at the end.

97% of respondents stated they would attend future events with 3% unsure.
