Feedback snapshot: 41% of attendees provided feedback

85% of respondents would attend future events with 15% not sure.

92% of respondents believe there are benefits in holding regular multidisciplinary and multiservice CoPs for the area, 8% were not sure

69% reported they have met or become aware of a new service as a result of attending

46% reported attending had impacted their day to day work with 46% reporting this had been their first CoP.
