Share your experiences providing care to people vulnerable to loneliness and social isolation?

We are conducting research which aims to gain a better understanding of the experiences of loneliness of people living with a long-term health condition (such as asthma, arthritis, obesity, diabetes, or chronic pain). The study also aims to explore the experiences of health- and community-care professionals who provide care and support for people experiencing social isolation or loneliness. The study findings will provide a better understanding of loneliness to guide health practice and policy to improve support and care for people living with long-term health conditions.

We are interested in speaking to community- and health-care workers about their experiences providing care and support to people living with long-term health conditions who are experiencing, or vulnerable to loneliness.

If you are interested in taking part, we would like to interview you for about 30 min about your experiences of providing care to people living with a long-term health condition and experiencing loneliness or social isolation. The interviews will take place at a time and place convenient to you, either in person, by telephone or via video (e.g. Zoom/Teams).
